

PREREQUISITES POLICY

All EMSTA students must have the following prerequisites turned in:

- High School Diploma (or transcripts showing completion of 12th grade or GED)
- Driver's License or CA ID Card
- Social Security Card or Passport
- CPR Card (Must be Healthcare provider or Professional Rescuer level)
- Current Medical Insurance Coverage
- Current inoculations:
 - o Tuberculosis (TB): Test must be less than 1 (one) year old
 - o Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)
 - o Chicken Pox (Varicella): Can have parent write letter stating you had it at___ age.
 - o Tetanus: Must be less than 10 (ten) years old
 - o Hepatitis B Series: Recommended but can decline
 - Seasonal Flu/H1N1: Recommended but can decline

ALL prerequisites <u>MUST</u> be turned in <u>NO LATER</u> than 4 weeks after start of class in order to continue in the course. *Students will not be eligible to complete field or clinical experience until all prerequisites are turned in*. <u>Students will be dropped after the start of the 4th week if prerequisites are not turned in</u>. Exceptions may be made upon approval by the EMT Coordinator or the Office Manager.
