**Inoculations:**

***Tuberculosis (TB):*** must be less than 1 year old throughout the entire EMT - B course

***Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR):*** childhood inoculations usually documented on a long, yellow card

***Chicken Pox (Varicella):*** if not found on the yellow card, a signed, dated note from a parent stating you had Chicken Pox at \_\_\_ age is acceptable.

***Tdap if given 2005 or later (tetnus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis) Within 5 years***

***Hepatitis B:*** Recommended, but if declining, sign Declination form \* (in handout pkt)

***Seasonal Flu Vaccination / H1N1:*** Highly recommended, but if declining, sign Declination form \*

Notification of Disability Form - must turn in within 1 week of start of class and **MUST include medical documentation of disability.**
