



## PREREQUISITES POLICY

All EMSTA students must have the following prerequisites turned in:

- High School Diploma (or transcripts showing completion of 12<sup>th</sup> grade or GED)
- Driver's License or CA ID Card
- Social Security Card or Passport
- CPR Card (Must be Healthcare provider or Professional Rescuer level)
- Current Medical Insurance Coverage
- Current inoculations:
  - Tuberculosis (TB): Test must be less than 1 (one) year old
  - Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)
  - Chicken Pox (Varicella): Can have parent write letter stating you had it at \_\_\_ age.
  - Tetanus: Must be less than 10 (ten) years old
  - Hepatitis B Series: Recommended but can decline
  - Seasonal Flu/H1N1: Recommended but can decline

ALL prerequisites MUST be turned in NO LATER than 4 weeks after start of class in order to continue in the course. *Students will not be eligible to complete field or clinical experience until all prerequisites are turned in.* Students will be dropped after the start of the 4<sup>th</sup> week if prerequisites are not turned in. Exceptions may be made upon approval by the EMT Coordinator or the Office Manager.
